

JENNINGS COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING

August 6, 2026 @ 9:00AM

ANNEX BUILDING

Matt Sporleder, Alex Zimmerman, and Charlie St. John were present. Matt opened the meeting at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mitch Hansel with USI was hired by the county to help with the Title Six Implementation Plan and the ADA transition plan. Mitch has been working with Pam Hartwell to identify any deficiencies in the county buildings. Mitch submitted a resolution to the commissioners identifying Pam as the ADA Coordinator. Alex has not seen the resolution, so he reviews it before the commissioners give approval. Shane made a motion to adopt the resolution, Charlie seconds the motion, passed unanimously.

The Assessor submits a travel request for himself and another employee to attend an upcoming conference. This conference is a state-called conference so the expenses will be paid from county general. Matt asked who all was attending and Randy said that him, Angel, and his wife. He said that when he attends a conference with a female employee his wife always goes. There will be no additional expenses for the county. Shane made a motion to approve the request, Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

Justin said that the Eagle Scouts sent him the cost and what was needed for the repair of bricks around the courthouse. The sand is \$30.00 per bag, and they will need 111 bags. Justin suggests buying about half of that total to start. The commissioners said that Justin has the authority to spend up to \$5000.00 without their approval. Shane made a motion to allow Justin to purchase the materials needed and allow him to spend up to his normal limit. Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

Matt says that the highway supervisor position needs appropriated. Shane made a motion to recreate this position, Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

Shane made a motion to approve prior minutes, Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

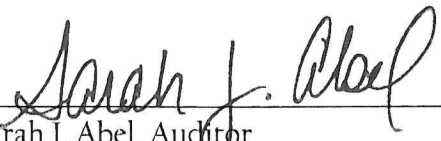
Shane made a motion to approve payroll and claims, Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

Matt received a request from the counties elevator company that they would like the county to agree to \$100.00 quarterly to supplement fuel cost for maintaining the elevator. Justin says that

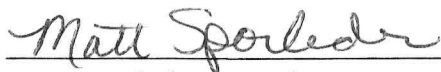

Shane made a motion to adjourn at 9:27am, Charlie seconded the motion, passed unanimously.



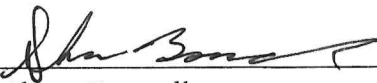
